

# FRIDAY NIGHT ON THE TOWN

Buses will depart Barry University at 6:45 P.M. and will pick you up at a designated time to take you back to Barry University. Transportation is included in the registration fee, but any other expenses incurred will be on your own.

## 1. BAYSIDE MARKETPLACE

Located on beautiful Biscayne Bay in downtown Miami, this open-air mall and marketplace features live entertainment, over 100 shops, and more than 20 restaurants.

Dine at Bubba Gump Shrimp Co. (based on the movie, *Forrest Gump*: \$15-\$20 per person), Latin American Cafe (Cuban food: \$10-\$15 per person), Los Ranchos — (Nicaraguan food: \$15-\$20 per person), or at the large international food court (\$5-\$10 per person). While at Bayside, take a relaxing scenic 90-minute guided boat tour of Biscayne Bay on the Island Queen. The cruise features views of the Miami skyline, Millionaire's Row, Star Island and Fisher Island. Cost of the boat cruise is \$16 per adult or \$7 for children 4-12. Children under 4 are free. If a group of 20 or more sign up, adult admission will be reduced to \$10 per adult.



## 2. CALLE OCHO/FLAMENCO SHOW

Get your fill of authentic Spanish cuisine including *tapas*, *paella*, and *sangria* at Casa Panza on Calle Ocho in historic Little Havana. Included with your meal is an exciting flamenco show, complete with festive Spanish music and dancing. Cost for the evening will range between \$30 and \$50, depending upon number of attendants. You may also have the opportunity to visit a gallery of Cuban art.

To make a group reservation at Casa Panza, a \$10.00 deposit per person is required by the restaurant. Please send a separate check for the deposit by July 9th.

## 3. LINCOLN ROAD

This popular Miami Beach hangout, a colorful pedestrian thoroughfare, is known for dining, shopping, the arts, and people watching. Shop at local boutiques or drop into a modern art gallery, both of which open late. Restaurants, ice cream shops and cafes abound on Lincoln Rd. (Average price per person for dinner is approximately \$15-\$25.) If the weather is nice, be sure to get an outdoor seat to take in the sights and sounds while people watching.
